BCAS has conducted research/case study on Impacts of Cyclone Sidr on Water Supply and Sanitation System in Coastal region of Bangladesh with support from CapNet. The results of this research were shared in a side event on Climate Change and Water resources held in May/June 2010 at Bonn, Germany. BCAS as the secretariat of CapNet Bangladesh is putting efforts in management of knowledge and strengthening international cooperation on water related issues. The total expenditure under this task was 3272 USD of which CapNet may be charged 3000 USD only.
